Work Group Updates	<p><b>Garden Workgroup</b> – Kari reported on the Garden Workgroup activities. The group had a seeding party at Network planting about 40 flats. There are 12-14 plots available now – Redwood will be utilizing 3-6 plots so that will leave 8-10 open to the community. Kari will be calling people that completed the survey and that stated they were interested in a community plot. Kari will be following up with St. Paul’s to see their status. Boys and Girls Club had showed interest in taking their kids to the St. Paul location. Per the survey results 57% of those who completed the survey stated that they would like a garden in the downtown area of Chambersburg. Representatives from the workgroup will be talking with the Rec. Center’s Advisory Board to get their thoughts on utilizing Mike Walters Park for a community garden location. They will also be exploring the possibility of receiving donated land. The workgroup is also giving some support to the Head Start gardens.</p> <p><b>Food Insecurity Workgroup</b> – The project plan has been finalized.
