Welcome	Sam Thrush called the meeting to order and welcomed the members.

Work Group Updates	<p>The workgroups reported updates since the last meeting:</p> <p>Community Engagement: The Get Fit Franklin County booklets have been printed and Heather is storing them in her office. The community engagement workgroup will focus on developing a preliminary distribution plan and will work on getting the hard copies out throughout the community.</p> <p>Built Environment: The built environment workgroup is still exploring partnerships including what entity would take on the liability of the pilot project. Summit Health is not interested. Alice Elia (Franklin County Library System) and Sam Thrush (DCI) are evaluating the possibility of applying for the County’s Tourism & QOL of grant for the project; the application deadline is at the end of the month.</p>	
Review year-end scorecard/discuss year 3	The group reviewed the year-end scorecard. One change that occurred throughout the year revolved around the walking parties. Earlier in the year, the group attempted to recruit more volunteers/community members to get involved in the planning process as it was getting more time consuming, but this was not successful. At this time, this may not be the best focus for the physical activity taskforce because other walking groups throughout the community do exist. The group also noted just how important social engagement is as it relates to physical activity. The group also discussed continuing efforts on the bike share program. Although initial prospective partners were not able to take on liability, there are still other options to keep pursuing.	
Partner Updates	Healthy Communities Partnership: The Go Girls Go race will be held on October 27. The new season starts at the end of August with the beginning of the new school year and will be implemented in 4 schools.
