Welcome/ Member Updates	<p>Nickie welcomed the members and introductions were made.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• James Bailes reported that WIC had a very successful event at the Farmers Market with almost 90 people attending. They hope to make this an annual event.• Denise Esser reported that leftover food from the backpack program was taken to Free Lunches at Schools program and was very well received.• Steven Schmidt reported that he will be teaching a Health Psychology class in the fall at Wilson College that requires students to have a service component. Students will be available to participate in health behavior projects related to medical or hands-on.• Barb Houpt reported that the Chambersburg YMCA started a new Prevent T2 program. They also have been accepted into the Live Strong program and are looking for trainers.• Jamie Shultz reported that the Eat Well Play Hard program will be starting in the Fall.• Ann Spottswood reported that Community Services is promoting a summer safety campaign at the Franklin County Fair and invited members to attend the Tic Toss tournament.• Jay Eury reported that gleaning is underway and the produce stand has opened. SCCAP will be holding their first fundraising event (Glean-A-Mania) to support the Gleaning Program.• Nickie Fickel reported on behalf of HCP that the Kids POP program has 550 children enrolled with approximately 200 kids attending the Farmers Market weekly.• Nickie Fickel reported that Summit Health has started a new Prevent T2 series and the Get Fit Now program will be starting. They will be	

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	partnering with the Eat Well Play Hard program in the fall and holding Grocery Store tours.	
Work Group Updates	<p>Garden Workgroup – Kari Coleman and Jay Eury reported on the Garden Workgroup activities. Jay reported on the Container Planting event that was held in May. Approximately 150 planters were created and distributed with a card containing information on joining the Facebook group. The goal is to eventually transfer ownership of this event from SCCAP to the Garden workgroup. Kari reported that she met with the Housing Authority regarding beautification process and community gardens. July 28 is the Beautification Event. Teams will work on selected bed with Master Gardeners. The group continues to look at expanding lots. A survey was completed at Mike Waters Park and Tanya Nitterhouse has offered a space. Discussions have also been held with Boys & Girls Club regarding build their own garden. The workgroup donated 150 tomato plants to Kids POP.</p> <p>Food Insecurity Workgroup – Jay Eury reported for the Food Insecurity workgroup. Tara Davis, SNAP Outreach Coordinator for Central PA Foodbank gave a presentation at the last workgroup meeting. The workgroup brainstormed ways that they could partner with Central Foodbank, possibly collaborating on mapping locations of food assistance providers around the County, as the Foodbank does similar mapping.</p>
