Old Business Uninsured Children Within Keystone's System	After some research, Pam found that there are approximately 300-350 uninsured children who visited Keystone in 2015. This is a big improvement over previous years.

Review of Preliminary Findings of CHNA and Secondary Information	(Reports provided.) Joanne asked the members to break into groups and review the information in the reports which were provided. The groups then reported back on some of the biggest concerns they saw from the statistics. Topics brought up included: 30-33% of Franklin County residents are illiterate (they have less than an 8 th grade education), a lack of education leads to difficulty in understanding physician instructions, the number of insured Hispanics and African Americans is lower than that of Caucasians, ESL gaps exist in obtaining insurance and healthcare, some religious organizations are against health insurance, the number of children qualifying for free summer meals is rapidly increasing, and poor dental health due to a lack of fluoride in the public water supply. (Joanne is interested in partnering with any of the members who would like to work together to provide dental sealants to children in the community.)
