The group reviewed the June 2018 minutes.

The group reviewed the Nutrition Task Force CHIP 2017/18 score card and the proposed 2018-2019 Action Plan. There were suggestions to review performance measures and make changes to the action plan that may demonstrate impact of the program and possibly health outcomes.

- Add performance measure “# and % of people who increased vegetable intake in Get Fit Now program”
- Add performance measure “# and % of participants who lost 5% or more of their weight in Prevent T2 program”
- Add performance measure “# and % of participants in Prevent T2 who lost weight”
- Add performance measures to Healthy Eating Adventure:
 - “# and % of participants who’s blood pressure decreased”
 - “# and % of participants who lost weight”
 - “# and % of participants who’s cholesterol decreased”
- Add performance measure to publicize partnering organizations’ activities and events that reflect “engagement” and “reach” on social media promotions
- Add performance measures under promote WIC voucher and senior voucher programs
 - # vouchers redeemed
 - # vouchers given out
- Change activity “Pilot community garden skills workshop (s) winter/spring” to “Community Garden Symposium” to share best practices in early spring; partner with Wilson College.
- DELETE:
 - Assess feasibility of Chambersburg Hospital community garden, serving local food in cafeteria
 - Assess mobile food market concept with larger scale employers including Summit Health
