	<p>Laura and Josh discussed barriers with the Hound Pack program. Enrolling/re-enrolling was a challenge this year; they worked to make the process easier. They are gearing up for food drive/outreach activities; Josh will food drive flyers. Laura noted that the food is not healthy. They are trying to be more thoughtful about holding food over the holidays. They are concerned about whether the food is being used or not. Another barrier is that 15% of the student population is not coming to a bricks and mortar school; how can they connect with homeschoolers who might be in need. Nickie will send Laura a contact with the Homeschoolers Association. Courtney shared that she is on the Charitable Review Committee at Volvo Corporation and she may have some ideas about how to partner with Hound Packs.</p>
