Bike Share/Library – Project Feasibility Update

Noel reported that she reached out to Bell Insurance regarding liability insurance. Bell Insurance does not have an existing carrier who was willing to provide coverage without either a premise liability policy or replacement policy. The agent suggested that we reach back out to the library to see if they would extend their current insurance program to include the pilot program and or add the group/project on as “additional insured”. Noel will follow up with the library again. Sam did not ask the Bike/Ped advisory committee about the Borough taking on the liability of the project. Elizabeth is going to ask Jeff Heverly about the Borough’s implementation of enhanced timing for bike/ped/traffic infrastructure.

L RTP

Elizabeth shared the draft L RTP link with the committee and information about the public workshop, scheduled for October 10. Public comments can be submitted through October 12. The goal is to have the MPO adopt the L RTP at its November 14 meeting. Elizabeth confirmed that the Cumberland Valley Rail Trail Extension from Shippensburg to Chambersburg is included in the L RTP.
